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1. Introduction

Registration is done through the Lifelong Learning Centre of the Universitat Politècnica de València (UPV). The platform will guide you to create a user account that will allow you to register, pay, request an invoice and later download the certificate. Payment can be made by bank card or bank transfer. In case of paying by transfer, you must attach proof of payment.

The registration process is individual and in the case of the teams, only those members that were already in the Excel file sent to the EHW organizing team will be allowed to follow this registration process.

EHW talks will be free for every member of the participating teams, however, there will be a maximum of attendees per team to assure that the capacity of the events where the talk will be physically held is fulfilled.



Furthermore, you will be allowed to access to the UPV during the entire week but not to the talks (unless a ticket is purchased in Questions 5 and 6 or if you are granted access under your classification).

- a. Merchandising package (15€) - included for participant team members, however one can purchase an extra package if desired. Other participants can highlight this option to get a merchandising package.*
- b. Design competition viewer - Participating teams and Technical Jury are, by definition, design competition viewers. A recommended option for those who would like to view the showcases and demonstrations of student teams. Refer to the week schedule for more information on the design competition.*
- c. Circuito Ricardo Tormo prototype demonstrations (Saturday 24th July) - Participating teams and Technical Jury are, by definition, design competition viewers at the Circuit Ricardo Tormo. Members of the public should pick this option if they wish to see the Complete Pod runs on Saturday.*
